1. See General Livestock Rules.

- 2. Health: See General Rules: Livestock Health Requirements.
- 3. Minimum weight is 900 lbs. No maximum weight limit.
- 4. Classes will be determined by hip height. Final class breaks will be at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 5. Spaces for trim chutes on the concrete slab will be assigned by the Superintendent.
 Only one space per exhibitor will be assigned.
- 6. Fitting Regulations are as follows: Steers may only be washed, blown and combed prior to judging and classification. Absolutely NO artificial coloring, glues or adhesives will be allowed, no exceptions, while on the SNMSF&R premises. Steers may be subject to a white towel/glove test at any time. Violators of this rule may be disqualified from the show.
- 7. There will be no feeding in the bedding area.
- 8. Awards: Buckles and rosettes to the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Ribbons will be awarded to the top six places in each class.
- 9. Junior Livestock Sale: A total of 10 Market Steers will be sold in the Sale.
- 10. Showmanship classes (Novice, Junior and Senior) will follow the Grand Drive. Junior Market Steers and Beef Heifers will be considered for Beef Showmanship. All interested contestants need to enter on-line.
